

How to access and search the ‘new look’ INSOL Europe: European Insolvency Regulation Case Register on Lexis+




Step 1: Navigate to: <http://www.lexisnexis.co.uk/en-uk/home.page> and select your product, Lexis+UK where you will see this screen:




Step 2: Click log in and enter your username in the <ID> field and the password in the <password> field. After entering all the information, tick <Remember Me> (this will ensure you don't need to re-enter your credentials when you log in from the same device) and click <Sign in>.


Step 3: After signing in, click the ‘My Sources’ tab, where you can see two options: ‘Search Sources’ and ‘View All Sources’.



Step 4: Click on 'Search Sources' to see this page:



Step 5: Type in <INSOL Europe> in the 'Search for a source' box and click on the magnifying glass icon at the far right which will take you to this page:



Step 6: Click on 'INSOL Europe: European Insolvency Regulation Case Register', where you'll be taken to this page:

Step 7: Searching by browsing: From the search screen, you can see the countries listed in alphabetical order.

You can then drill down into each country by clicking on the <+> box to see all cases from that country listed by year in reverse chronological order.

Then, click on the box to see each case.
